This hearing has been held through video conferencing.

This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts of the case are that the Appellants filed the Memo of Appeal on 15.03.2021 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 17.03.2021, intimated the defects to the Appellants on the same day and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on 31.03.2021. The Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 08.04.2021. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that due to surge in COVID-19 case and limited mobility, it took time to remove the defects. Hence, there is delay of 15 days in re-filing the Memo of Appeal, so, the same may be condoned.
