



May 2018 and thereafter, due to Court vacations, the conducting lawyer himself was out of station and when he came back, he re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 10.07.2018 and in doing so there is a delay of 53 days.

4. Now the point for consideration is:

- i) Whether the Appellant has explained the reasons for delay in filing the Memo of Appeal?
- ii) Whether the Appellants are entitled to get any other relief?

5. Considering the grounds mentioned in the Supplementary Application and the submissions of the Appellant, the delay in re-filing the Memo of Appeal is hereby condoned. However, there is also delay in filing the Memo of Appeal, so same may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench for admission as well as for hearing on the point of limitation.

6. The Point No.1 is answered accordingly. So far as the Point No.2 is concerned, the Appellant is not entitled for any other relief.

7. With the aforesaid order, this Miscellaneous as well as Supplementary Applications stand disposed of.

8. As prayed by learned counsel, put up on 23.07.2018 before the Hon'ble Bench for hearing on the point of limitation and admission.
