This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Memo of Appeal on 09.01.2020 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 10.01.2020, intimated the defects returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on the same day. The Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 21.01.2020. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that the Counsel attempted to re-file the Appeal but the Registry was closed on 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> January, 2020.
