This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Memo of Appeal on 19.12.2019 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 20.12.2019, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on 26.12.2019. The Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 03.01.2020. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that the impugned order wrongly recorded the number of the petition before the NCLT, Chennai and for correction of the same, the Appellant filed an application. The certified copy of the corrected order was received by the Advocates for the Appellant at New Delhi on 02.01.2020.
