This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Interlocutory Application (for recall of order) on 09.01.2020 and the Office after scrutiny of the same on 09.01.2020, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on 21.01.2020. The Appellant re-filed the Interlocutory Application (for recall of order) on 27.01.2020. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that on the date of re-filing the Appellant was informed that an application for condonation of delay in re-filing is required, which took some time. Hence, there is delay of seven days in re-filing the IA (for recall of order), so, the same may be condoned.
