This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Memo of Appeal on 12.09.2019 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 13.09.2019, intimated the defects and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on 13.11.2019. The Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 13.11.2019. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that the main counsel was unwell and hence not available to be able to scrutinize and remove the defects which led to delay of 54 days in re-filing, so, the same may be condoned.

3. Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the Appellant, perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report. The Appellant was required to re-file the Memo of Appeal within seven days from the date of intimation of the defects. However, the Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal with a delay of 54 days, hence, the case may be placed before the Hon'ble Bench for appropriate orders. IA is disposed of accordingly.
